

The school song was written by Mr J F Spies and composed by Dr Guurt van der Tas in August 1989.





Timetable

At Parel Vallei we follow a 10-day cycle timetable. Day 1 starts on the Monday of the first week and Day 6 follows at the start of the following week.

New learners will receive their timetable in the first week of school.

School times from Monday to Thursday will be 07:40 to 14:20 while on a Friday learners will start at 07:40 and finish at 13:30.

Formal test periods are on a Tuesday and Thursday, while class tests can be written during class time on any given day.

Subject choice GET phase

Gr 8 and 9 - A learner takes 9 subjects.

Languages - English and Afrikaans: Of the two languages taken, one must be a Home Language. (*A learner may select two Home Language options, but may not select two First Additional Language options.)*

- 1. English Home Language *or* English First Additional Language.
- 2. Afrikaans Huistaal of Afrikaans Eerste Addisionele Taal.
- 3. Life Orientation
- 4. Mathematics
- 5. Natural Sciences (Physical Sciences and Life Sciences offered separately)
- 6. Social Sciences (Geography and History offered separately)
- 7. Economic Management Sciences
- 8. Technology
- Creative Arts One of the following two options is selected: Drama & Design or Drama & Music

Extra-curricular subjects: French / German on Second Additional Language level.

Subject choice FET phase

Gr 10 to 12 - A learner must take a minimum of 7 subjects.

Languages - English and **Afrikaans**: Of the two languages taken, one MUST be a HOME LANGUAGE (A learner may select two Home language options, but may not select two First Additional Language options.)

Compulsory subjects:

- 1. English Home Language *or* English First Additional Language.
- 2. Afrikaans Huistaal of Afrikaans Eerste Addisionele Taal.
- 3. Pure Mathematics *or* Mathematical Literacy
- 4. Life Orientation.
- 5-7. **Three** of the following choice subjects must be chosen:

*Music: We offer tuition in the following instruments: Piano, Keyboard, Singing, Violin, Viola, Clarinet, Saxophone, Ukulele, Guitar, Bass Guitar, Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Percussion and Drums.

8th Subject: Should a learner wish to take an 8th subject in the FET phase, it must be taken from the beginning of Gr 10.

Extra-curricular subjects: French / German on Second Additional Language level.

Dress code and appearance

Pride in the school is of paramount importance.

- 1. School uniforms must be clean and neat. Sponsored clothing may not be worn to school.
- 2. Learners must wear the correct shoes.

Boys: polished, black lace-up and black sole shoes without large labels or buckles.

Girls: T-bar or lace-up black school shoes or black sole shoes with one strap over the foot.

- 3. It is compulsory to wear you school blazer every day in the winter, inside and outside of the school. In terms 1 and 4 blazers are only compulsory for formal events. The school blazer is always the only outer garment. Boys' top blazer button must be fastened.
- 4. Jerseys may be worn, but not without the school blazer and never as an outer garment outside the school grounds. Shirts must be tucked in. Only the Matrics have the privilege of wearing the white Matric jersey as an outer garment in terms 1 and 4 and under the school blazer in terms 2 and 3.
- 5. During the summer terms, the boys must wear a short-sleeved shirt with the school badge. Boys may also wear the school tie in the summer. Girls must wear the short-sleeved shirt with the school badge and the prescribed skirt or pants as sold by the official supplier of the PV school uniform, De Jagers.
- 6. Boys must wear black or grey belts with long pants to keep their shirts tucked in.
- 7. Shorts for PE: Only the longer type (as received in the beginning of Grade 8) may be worn.
- 8. Learners must wear suitable underwear that is not visible.

9. Socks - Only the prescribed school socks and tights are permitted.

Boys: School: Long, grey PV school socks to be worn with shorts.

Grev socks with long pants

Sport/PE: Short, white school socks with blue stripe, sold by

De Jagers.

Girls: Summer: Short, white school socks with blue stripe.

Winter: Opaque tights - not sheer/knitted.

White socks may not be worn with long pants. No socks may be worn underneath tights.

Sport/PE: Short, white school socks with blue stripe, sold by

De Jagers.

- 10. The only jewellery that may be worn is a wrist watch. Girls may wear ONE small, plain, gold or silver stud or sleeper in each ear lobe.
- 11. Winter uniform must be worn in terms 2 and 3. A tie is compulsory with the winter uniform and the boys' top button must be buttoned up. Girls may not wear the short sleeve shirt during winter.

The rain jacket may be worn in terms 2 and 3, but only with the school blazer. In terms 1 and 4 the rain jacket may be worn without the school blazer, but only on the days that it rains. The rain jacket may be worn with the school tracksuit.

- 12. Nails should be clean and should not extend beyond the fingertips. Only colourless nail polish is allowed. Nails must look natural and be well groomed. No artificial nails. Make-up is not permitted.
- 13. **Boys**: Hair must be short and well-groomed. Sideburns should not reach lower than mid-ear. Boys must be shaven at all times.
 - **Girls**: If hair extends lower than the shirt collar it should be kept together with suitable hair elastics or ribbons. It must be neat and well-groomed. White, black and navy hair elastics/ribbons and clips are allowed. Gel may be used in moderation. Refer to the school's Code of Conduct for further guidelines.
- 14. Length of skirts must be decent. (Four fingers from the knee could be used as a guideline for the appropriate length of the skirts.)
- 15. Navy-blue gloves and scarves sold by De Jagers are permitted in winter.
- 16. Sportswear, as specified, is compulsory for sports events and practices. NO sneakers allowed.
- 17. ONLY PV schoolbags and sport bags are allowed.

In regards to electronic devices / cellphones we would like to highlight the following:

Cellphones and electronic devices may only be used with the permission of a teacher between 07:40 and 14:20.

Earphones are not allowed during school hours or outside of the school while learners are still in school uniform.







D6 Communicator



The school uses the D6 Communicator as an easy source of communication between the school, learners and the parents. Information appears immediately and, in the event of an urgent notice, the school can immediately inform users. The D6 Communicator can be downloaded to a computer, laptop and/or smart phone.

Parel Vallei Communicate



Parel Vallei Communicate is a new platform that was created to serve as a one-way communication between Parel Vallei and its learners. (POPIA protocol applies). No private WhatsApp groups with reference to the school are allowed.

Each grade is divided into two groups - Afrikaans and English. All grade related information is shared on these group. By using WhatsApp, the learners are able to receive information daily.

The learners join the group by scanning a QR code that will be provided.

There is only one *Admin* on the group and only the *Admin* can send messages. The Parel Vallei Communicate cellphone number is not there to answer learners' personal questions. Any questions that a learner might have can be addressed to their class representatives.

EduVista

EduVista is a complete school management system accessed by all stakeholders.



The **PV Parent Portal** - This portal allows the parent to log in to EduVista and:

- 1. Access their child's information such as his/her: personal information, school reports, timetable, detailed attendance record, subjects and teacher contact details, involvement in extra-curricular activities, documentation etc.
- 2. Perform a variety of functions such as: update / change, personal information, upload and view absentee notes, download / print school reports, subject selection, etc.

Information and log in details will be e-mailed to the parents before school opens in 2025.

The StudyHub - This personalized portal gives the learner to access the following:

Subject curriculum with all topic-based study materials, PowerPoints, videos etc., their own timetable, personal info., test & exam timetables, teacher contact info., on-line meeting facilities, up-load facilities, interactive Q & A, track their own progress etc.

Learners are given their access details to the StudyHub on their first day of school.
